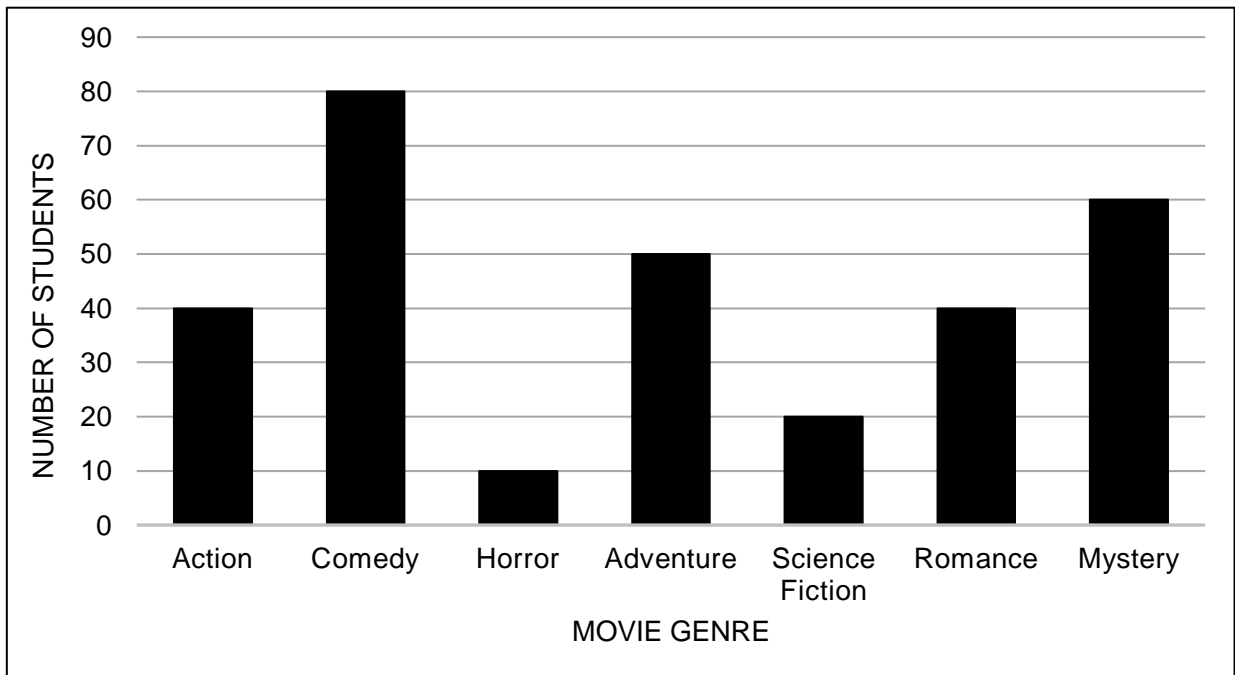

次の英文を読んで、あとの各問いに答えなさい。

Do you like animals? Do you have any pets at home? No matter what kind of animals you have, they are sure to be your loving friends or part of your family. Among them, there are animals that are always beside us human beings, and help us in many ways. They are dogs!

There has been a very long relationship between humans and dogs. It is said that dogs first became our partners when humans were hunters at least ten thousand years ago. Originally dogs were wolves. Wild ones lived in groups and stayed away from humans. Gentle ones, however, began to help people when they hunted and stayed with them, becoming “pet dogs”.

Dogs also feel close to humans because their brains are similar to ours. They are not the smartest animals, but they are as clever as 2 year-old children. Some are able to understand more than 150 human words. They know their own names, words like “sit” or “wait”, greetings, and the names of some kinds of food. They can also understand their favorite things, such as “walk” or “go out”, and what they dislike, such as “hospitals” or “stay alone”. Also, dogs have such a good sense of smell that they may know when their owners are (①) through the smell of their sweat or breath. The American Medical Association* reported a small test in which dogs successfully found cancer in humans in 98% of cases.

Police dogs, guide dogs, service dogs and rescue dogs all work for people. “Therapy dogs” visit people in hospitals and nursing homes every week, which is good for both the people’s physical and mental health. Therapy dogs can also help young children to learn to read. Some young children are very shy and don’t want to read in front of their classes at school, but by being with dogs, they can relax enough to focus on their reading. Those children enjoy learning with dogs because dogs never laugh at them, even when they make mistakes.

All these things show us that dogs are very close to us humans. A report from the University of London also lets us see how much dogs understand us and love us. Researchers reported that dogs can understand human feelings and show kindness to us, especially when we are feeling (②). A study at the university found that dogs came toward people who were crying rather than those who were singing happily.

It can be said that living with dogs makes our lives richer and happier. Don’t you think so?
