*Aesop was a Greek writer who lived more than 2,500 years ago. The stories that he wrote are called *fables. Fables are never about true events. Aesop's fables are very famous for two reasons.

First, each of his fables has a *moral. People say that fables are a beautiful way to teach children about morals, which are sometimes not so easy or fun to teach. However, his fables are (A) enough for the young children to understand the messages they carry. For many years they have been telling children important lessons about life, nature, love, friendship, and being a good person.

Second, Aesop wrote many fables about animals or plants that spoke and acted like humans. Children like reading the stories about the unique characters, and ①when children can see themselves in them, they understand the morals even better.

Whenever children open up a book of fables, they will learn how to act in new or difficult situations, how to work with people around them, how to accept everyone for who they are, and how to tell what is the wrong choice and what is the good one. These are necessary tools that will stay with them for their whole life. With ②these, they will be able to solve problems, especially when they need to understand their own feelings and other people's feelings. This is something very important because all through life they will have to work with many people who are (B) themselves.

The following is one of Aesop's famous fables:

Two travelers, who were tired from the heat of the summer sun, were looking for a place to rest. Finally, they were able to find some shade under the wide-spreading branches of a tree. As they rested under its shade looking up among the nice leaves, they saw it was a *Plane Tree.

"How *useless the Plane Tree is!" said one of them. It gives no fruit and makes the ground dirty with leaves.

"You *ungrateful people!" said an angry voice from the Plane Tree. "You rest here and enjoy my cooling shade, but you say I am useless!"

Through this simple story, Aesop wanted to tell us that many of us act like these men. (C)
